1) PUBLIC COMMENT

2) FIBER TO THE PREMISE INITIATIVE

- a. Update on recent construction activities and costs associated with the Alpha Phase.
 - Construction, including restoration of the Southeast Area, is expected to be complete in Mid-October.
 - Edison has expedited activities in the Bedford / Ambassador area but may not sustain this level effort for the course of the entire project. Typical turnaround time for pole application process is 90 days.
 - Bedford / Ambassador area completion still depends on design efforts (Uptown Services) and construction (Henkels and McCoy). Estimated time of completion is mid-November.

- Staff will document several proof of concept milestones achieved during the Alpha Phase. Those include:
 - 1. Installation of temporary utility poles
 - 2. Fiber pulls to the Bedford / Ambassador area
 - 3. Documenting path and costs of fiber pulls to test-user homes
 - 4. Performance evaluation of current contractors
 - 5. Other options for project such as leasing or municipal uses
- Staff will return to Council in August with a progress report.
- b. Potential Health Concerns of 5G- This topic is slated for a Council meeting in August or September at the request of Mayor Mirisch. Staff provided an overview and there was a general discussion on the subject.
